## Chapin Academy High School Resource Page

At a minimum, College Prep students must have 24 credits as follows:

- English, 4 credits
- Math, 4 credits to include Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, and a 4th higher level math
- Science, 3 credits (at least 2 lab courses) *
- US History, 1 credit
- American Government, 0.5 credits
- Economics, 0.5 credits
- Other Social Studies, 1 credit
- Physical Education, 1 credit
- Computer Science, 1 credit
- Foreign Language, 2 credits
- Fine Arts, 1 credit
- Electives, 5 credits
* The SC Commission on Higher Education and some colleges require that all three science courses be lab sciences. Please check the college you plan to attend for specific requirements.


## The following chart is for a student who begins their $8^{\text {th }}$ grade year with Chapin Academy. New students may take courses as needed but may have time conflicts with other courses offered.

Chapin Academy is a College Prep program that also requires some courses to be taken as Honors. Students have a choice between College Prep (CP) or Honors (H) with Math and Literature courses only. All Science and History are honor level courses. Electives are college prep.
*Spanish 3 is recommended or dual enrollment. Some universities are requiring 3 foreign language credits even though it is not a graduation requirement.
**PE needs 150 hours to receive a full credit. Chapin Academy can offer $1 / 2$ credit and parent can log additional 75 hours of physical activity/sport and report full credit to accountability group.
***Homeschool students can also receive a full music credit if they play an instrument. Log
150 hours of lessons/practice/performances and report to your accountability group.

## Dual Enrollment:

$11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ graders can begin dual enrollment at a Technical College, Newberry College, or online with various colleges. The technical colleges will be free if 2 or more classes are taken. Four-year colleges will offer a reduced rate per course. Some recommended courses to begin with are English 101 and 102, Social Sciences, Foreign Language, College Algebra and Statistics.

High School Students and College Sports: Chapin Academy has NCAA pre-approved courses. If your student plans to play a sport in college, you must notify Chapin Academy Administrator, Shawn Hammond, to assist you with eligibility.
